Here you can walk through very picturesque lanes to flavour the very intimate aspect of the town which is the ideal for a drink in the open air or a good shopping time of local products : inlaid wood work, clothes and leather goods.

Click for details and prices One of the most important commercial ports in Roman times situated at the mouth of the river Sarno. Buried by the devastating force of Mount Vesuvius in 79 A.D. rediscovered by chance 16 centuries later is the most visited archaeological site in Italy. There you can visit the Forum area, the Theatres area, the Baths, and some of the best preserved houses with the original mosaic floors, frescoed walls and in some monuments you can still see some of the plaster casts of the inhabitants who were suffocated by the ashes erupted from the volcano.

Click for details and prices Mt Vesuvius is the best known volcano on earth; it dominates the Bay of Naples with its characteristic cone. It is a typical example of a volcano in a volcano made by an outer broken cone, Mt Somma (1133 metres) with a crateric belt most of which is destroyed. In it there is a smaller cone, the Mt Vesuvius (1281 metres), divided by lowering named Valle del Gigante (Giants Valley).
